## Vogel Alcove

This is accomplished through the provision of high quality, free childcare and developmental services, and comprehensive social services.

## Good Shepherd Community Center

The Good Shepherd Community Center center was established to assist local families with child care for preschoolers ages 18 months to five years, as well as before and after-school daycare for older children up to the fifth grade. The goal is to provide a safe, healthy and nurturing environment where children can be better prepared to learn in school and to compete in the world. All children are eligible for admission without regard to their religion or faith.
